Instructions

Session Concept

Modeled after the style of Instagram, this session aims to convey research through a single, image-centered pdf-slide without any animations or other effects. Each of the nine presenters will prepare a single, image-focused slide—without animations or effects—serving as a graphical abstract that highlights the key messages of their study.

Presenter Instructions

Your task is to present your project visually on one slide. Please prepare this slide in advance, using PowerPoint or a PDF format. Keep it focused: showcase only the most essential findings to create a clear and impactful snapshot.

When presenting, narrate your study journey concisely. Start with a brief background, then walk us through the highlights and results of your project, and close by situating your findings within the broader research context.

Timing

Each presenter has 6 minutes to deliver their project overview and results, followed by 3 minutes for Q&A from both the chairs and audience.

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Research Podcast Session

Instructions

Session Concept

“The Research Podcast” adopts the format of podcast interviews. One moderator will be on stage with you, engaging in a discussion about your project. There will be five presenters in this session. Craft a compelling storyline to illustrate your study and its findings. Notes are permitted, but no slides or visual aids will be shown to the audience.

Presenter Instructions

The moderator will interview you about your project, focusing on the following areas:

- (i) Scientific Background: What is already known about this topic? What gaps have you identified in the existing literature?
- (ii) Methods: What methodology did you employ? Which population did you include, and why did you choose these methods? How did you analyse your results (statistical analysis)?
- (iii) Results: What were your main findings? Were there any interesting side findings?
- (iv) Discussion: Do your results align with existing literature? Is there additional evidence to support your findings? What questions remain unanswered? Have new questions emerged from your research?

!! You are encouraged to connect with your moderator at least once before the session !!

Timing

Each interview will last 12 minutes, followed by a 5-minute Q&A from both the chairs and the audience.
